
International Vedic Mathematics Olympiad (IVMO 2022)

26th November 2022

The 2nd International Vedic Mathematics Olympiad was held on 26th November 2022, to test the use of Vedic Maths techniques, speed of thought and mathematical acumen.

There were six levels of entry,

- 1. Primary A
- 2. Primary B
- 3. Junior
- 4. Intermediate
- 5. Senior
- 6. Open.



Each test consisted of 50 multiple choice questions which were to be answered within one hour. The competition was made available both online and offline and managed through Centre Coordinators. We had over 1800 entries, whi ch was a three-fold increase from the first year. Competitors came from ten countries. The majority of entries came from the Philippines thanks to the amazing work of Ike Prudente who runs several VM centres there and has encouraged schools to take part.





Participants were awarded certificates, gold, silver, and bronze for the top 10%, next 20% and next 30%.
